

Installation Instructions for Dpit Package based on:

1. Download the Dpit package and place it in a certain location (e.g., Desktop).

2. Install the Dpit package. There are two ways to do this.

a. In RStudio, click these options in the following order: In the bottom left corner, hit the “Packages” tab -> click “Install” -> choose “Package Archive File” from the “Install from:” menu -> click “Browse...” -> select the Dpit package where it was placed.

b. Or, enter a command line and make sure to edit the path depending on where the Dpit package is located on your computer. For example:
`install.packages("~/Desktop/Dpit_1.0.tar.gz", repos = NULL, type = "source")`

3. Load the Dpit package

```
require(Dpit)
```
